



## KANJI

The table lamp Kanji reinterprets traditional Oriental portable lanterns in a contemporary key. Drawing inspiration from Chinese porcelain from the Ming dynasty. The diffuser is adorned with a pleated surface decoration. A Led ring runs inside the structure and magically illuminates the diffuser. Evocative of the Far East not only in form but in name (kanji are characters of Chinese origin used in Japanese writing in conjunction with the hiragana and katakana syllabaries), it is designed to be used alone or in pairs, with each form amplifying the aesthetic power of the other.

Table lamp with diffused and dimmable light. Painted metal frame. Diffuser made of frosted color and blown glass. Black power cable, dimmer and plug. Plug-in power supply with interchangeable plugs (UK - USA - UE- CHN). Integrated led.
